Receipts towards the various program was Rs. 3,86,28,068.13, Sponsorship received during the year was Rs. 1,47,54,195.48. The surplus during the year for appropriation was Rs. 16,66,029.21.

<u>Item no. 13Address by the Outgoing President, Dr. Jaydeep Tank</u>

A very good morning to all. I hope all of you are keeping safe, well and healthy. I am certain the pandemic and the Lockdown have not got you down. But if it has, one my closely held belief as an implacable optimist is that people who wonder whether the glass is half full or half empty are missing the point.

The Glass is refillable.

For me this an opportunity for thanksgiving and celebration. Gratitude to all those who made this MOGS year what it was and celebration for what i know will be a glorious year and future for MOGS. As I look back on this year I am fully conscious that this was possible because I listened to those who came before me and counted on those who will come after me.

The typical MOGS year centres around continuing medical education. You will receive details at the AGM and have in fact lived through and contributed to the activities. I am loath to reiterate but, it may interest you to know that counting from April when we took over to around the March 15th when activities stopped due to Covid 19 there are around 49 weekends. In this much time, we had around 59 CME activities touching well over 9000 Obstetricians and Gynecologists.

Given that we had 59 CME activities in 49 weekends, it was not surprising that the activities spilled over to weekdays and there were days when there were more than one activity. This was not counting the several CSR and other activities and meetings we were involved in. although started off thinking that our activities were "Mutually Exclusive and Collectively Exhaustive" it is also true that they were "Mutually Exclusive and Collectively Exhausting"

We would like to believe that the conferences this year had excellent scientific content designed in an approachable and logical fashion - succinct yet comprehensive. I would like to thank all the office bearers and conveners of all our activities. The approach to the conferences as you must have discerned and as several of you have pointed out, went beyond the program - whether it were the brochures sent in the form of reusable folders, a uniform design with a cover art commissioned by Parikshit and me for the Dr D K Tank memorial conference almost a decade ago, the involvement of FOGSI, AOFOG and committees in each conference, and a FIGO committee in the Dialogue conference, and the Belgian Society of Reproductive Medicine for the workshop and GIC conference, a record number of international faculty - 6 for Dialogue + 11 for the GIC + 4 for the Annual Conference which meant our conferences had 21 International faculties, avoiding these of plastics in the conferences by QR Code delegate badges etc, conference bags sourced form entrepreunal women in urban slums, eco friendlymomentoes, financial prudence by raising enough money for the activities, and tight and innovative scientific programs also saw several innovations starting from new formats of presentation like the Pecha Kucha Sessions to involvement of youth council as full faculty and not only as MOC's etc. We devised tightly scheduled programs with short inaugurations and valedictories which I am happy to say we could complete punctually thanks to the wonderful efforts of the MOC's, speakers, chairs and panelists.

Dialogue 2019 was a rarity as a single hall full plenary conference with topics ranging from public private partnerships to SRHR to Medicolegal issues. The AOFOG BSRM MOGS course was run entirely with Foreign faculty with a program developed in close collaboration with the BSRM and the AOFOG RE committee was sold out days in advance. This despite a non residential registration fee priced at 25000 only for the two workshop days. It spoke to me for the demand for very high value and calibre scientific programs where demand exceeds capacity despite high registration fees. It was also delightful to go back to the Taj Mahal Hotel after more than a decade for a MOGS conference. I must say this about our MOGS annual conference. It is one of MOGS's most valuable intellectual properties. we must nurture it well and make it grow. Even though our annual conference this time was only one

weekend after the AICOG we still had a great attendance of close to a thousand delegates There were 103 free papers and 15 posters.

The MOGS Annual awards were also well thought of. We created a spreadsheet of all the MOGS awards handed out in our annual conferences and cross referenced them to the years and Presidents where the awards had been given. We did this to broaden the field of the awardees by looking beyond those who had received the awards earlier and include organisations who were supporting the work we were doing. We also awarded only the fourth ever fellowship of the MOGS.

The fellowship and conference evening programs were also well appreciated with the Friendship Bench, the performance of The Vagina Monologues, the talk from eminent TV personality and defence consultant Mr Maroof Raza and a performance by an Acapella band Aflatunes. During the annual conference a talent show and dance competition was performed by the MOGS members. I am constantly amazed by the talent and the abilities of our members. We also had a spread of board games for the attendees and karaoke. The board games used in the annual conference were then handed over to the children at the Don Bosco shelter for children for their use.

We were also fortunate to have the glamorous and spectacular World Conception to Delivery Conference C2D 2K19 was held on 23rd and 24th November 2019 at Hotel St Regis, Mumbai. The Conference was jointly organised under the leadership of Dr Nandita Palshetkar and Hrishikesh Pai by MOGS, FOGSI committees and MSR and was a huge success.

We were fortunate to do considerable work with the CMO's office and its CSR cell Sahabahag. On three separate days - 22nd April, 22nd May and 21st June, Saturation Screening, of all pregnant women registered with the Public health systems throughout the entire Palghar district was done. We had camps in 42 PHC's in these three days, screened and examined a total of 3275 pregnant women. Massive logistical effort involving the entire district administration right from the PHC, Sub centre and village level health workers. To give an idea about the logistics the camps involved hiring and tracking the progress of over fifty cars for transport of Doctors. Patients from village level were also given transportation by bring over 100 cars to transport patients from all the villages. The Camps were funded by the local administration, DHFL, JSW, L&T, Samta Foundation and Keshav Shrusthi. This resulted in the generation of microlevel data and advice for each pregnant woman who was then looked after till delivery by the PHC's. Feedback from all the Doctors was also taken to strengthen the local healthcare providers, the PHC infrastructure and human resource and the referral chains. I would like to thank all those who participated very enthusiastically in the camps. I hope they also gained some practical understanding about how our health systems work at the PHS and subcenter levels. I can say it was enriching for me to be part of this and understand these issues firsthand. We also did camps with MynaMahila in urban slums in Deonar.

The Mumbai Obstetrics & Gynaecological Society have donated 200 PPEs to all our 8 Municipal and Govt. Medical Colleges & General Hospitals of Mumbai city during this Covid19 outbreak. International Women's Day Cancer Awareness & Comprehensive Health Checkup Camp was organised by MOGS & FOGSI for Women Police force at 17 different centers all over Mumbai was held on 8th March 2020 from 8 am to 4 pm. We had announced a menstrual Hygiene project in April when I took over. However, this has not been rolled out yet. I thought it would be fiscally prudent to first ensure that we go through the years activities before we allot resources to it. I am happy that our fiscal plans of generating surplus only as much as is needed worked out and i would like to thank Rishma, Anahita and Rajendra for kindly agreeing to roll out this project in their tenure. We continued to be part of advocacy efforts and were part of committees to look at the cesareanrates, hysterectomy rates and abortion beyond 20 weeks in Maharashtra.

Organisationally, we strengthened e voting, introduced e voting for FOGSI nominations from the MCM, began the process of formalisation of the youth council TOR's, we will move soon to an electronic members database and the ability to fill the MOGS membership form and upload documents to our server directly and also pay membership fees online. We also stopped printing minutes of previous MCM for all members and saved over 3000 sheets of papers.

I trust that like in all the years gone by the MOGS Trustees, Office bearers, Managing Committee, youth council and above all the members got together in a well-coordinated minuet which allowed us to combine the beauty of the past with all the best hope of the future.

Our Trustees are always at hand to share their wisdom and give us invaluable advice. Thank you. I have now served under 20 Presidents of the MOGS and it has been wonderful to learn something from each one of them. I would like to thank them for all their kind support and guidance. Each of the office bearers has been wonderfully helpful, but I must specially thank Niranjan and Suvarna my administrative officers for their kindness and steadfast help throughout the year. I also must specially mention Sarita and Anahita for their wonderful and efficient help throughout the tenure. The Youth council has been wonderful and we hope that we have harvested its full potential.

I attended my first MOGS meeting when Dad was installed as the President of MOGS in 1986. I was elected to the Managing Committee in 1998 and It is my great fortune and privilege that today I am handing over as the President of this most premier of all societies. I hope my father is sitting in heaven with his favourite drink and feeling happy with my year as President. My Mom has congratulated me for the year and that is the best compliment i could ask for. Thank you to my sister Nivedita Kurush and Parul for all your help and support. A special thanks to Parikshit for all his help guidance, advise and hard work as I have juggled multiple commitments to multiple organisations this year. Sonali - my wife- was a particularly firm anchor as I struggled with deadlines and late nights to meet them. She would ask me - So what is it today - MOGS, FOGSI AOFOG or FIGO and then tell me I was coping well and in fact doing a good job. That was enough to spur me on and get on with it. Thanks to my sons Dev and Jash. I must tell them I will have some extra time on my hand and I hope they have figured out how they are going to handle spending that much more time with me. I am very thankful to all our team Ashwini: I J Uncle, Randive, Mayuri, Vivek, Sobiya, Hemlata, Sushma and above all Dr Amla Chati. Thanks are also due to team Varriance.

Finally, I would like to emphasise the role the MOGS office led by the very able Divyaben and Manohar play in running the enterprise that is the MOGS. Words are not enough to express my gratitude to them.

It's been a very fruitful year and I am very grateful for MOGS to have been a part of my life. I wish my good friends Rishma the new President, her secretary Anahita and treasurer Rajendra and the entire team all the very best. I am sure they will take MOGS to greater heights and benefit the women of Mumbai and the doctors who care for them.

In the end let me reiterate what I had said when I got installed.

What drives us forward in my view is the altruistic gene inherent in all those who chose Medicine as a profession. This altruistic gene is what gives us a burning desire to do good.

In conclusion as President of MOGS I have this to say- You know, I have always felt we don't appreciate ourselves enough. We are the premier society of a Federation which represents women Health, we are fervent advocates for women health and above all we save umpteen lives and bring happiness to so many women, men and create family units which are the driving force of today's society.
