President's Message

Dear MOGS members,

Greetings to all.

The Mumbai Obstetric and Gynaecological Society (MOGS) was founded in 1937 and is a founder member Society of the Federation of Obstetric and Gynaecological Societies of India (FOGSI). The Society is in its 86 th year with 2,291 members during 2022-2023 is one of the largest organisations of specialised professionals at local level, nationally and internationally. I present to you all the MOGS Annual Report of my Presidential tenure April 2022- April 2023. I was honoured to be installed as the 69th President of The Mumbai Obstetric and Gynaecological Society at the 88th AGM at Hotel Sofitel Hotel in April 2022. Dr Sarita Bhalerao, MOGS President (2021-2022) who was my classmate from GSMC 1985 batch handed over the baton to me and thus began my journey as President MOGS.

Team MOGS 2022-2023 has had a very fruitful year. I had the support of MOGS Secretary, Dr Rajendra Sankpal, MOGS Treasurer Dr Geetha Balsarkar, entire Managing Council, Office Bearers and Youth Council members. My MOGS Theme for this year was “Vision for HER: Heal Her, Educate Her, Respect Her” as I wanted to work towards improving every aspect of women’s health. I hope I have succeeded in achieving my goal. We have strived to bring MOGS respect and recognition on a national and international platform. During this year I had 6 MOGS conferences, 7 Workshops, 39 webinars and Outreach Programs, 6 Dr NA Purandare Teaching Programs, 5 social events and 4 MOGS newsletters.

Our first conference, MOGS-HER World Congress on Labor and Delivery was held on 16th and 17th of April 2022 at Hotel Sofitel BKC. It was preceded by the 1st ever AI enabled hands on Obstetric Skills and Drills workshop on 15th April 2022 at LTMMC Hospital with AI mannequins by Laerdal, Norway. This conference had 3 Orations by esteemed speakers Dr Jeanne Conry, FIGO President, Dr S Shanthakumari, FOGSI President & Dr P K Shah, Past President FOGS & MOGS, on unique topics and Logomachy which was a debate on the various obstetric topics. Mr Sharman Joshi, film actor was the Chief Guest along with FIGO President Dr Jeanne. This conference had 18 keynote addresses and international speakers from FIGO, WHO, RCOG, RCPI, JHPIEGO & ISUOG organizations.

Our next conference was the MOGS World Congress on Anemia (WCA 2022), a virtual conference on 7th May 2022. It had participation from International & National speakers from FIGO, SAFOG, IAP, NNF, API, RCOG and many other organizations. Dr Anne Beatrice Kihara, FIGO President Elect from Kenya was the Chief Guest along with Dr Conry as Guest of Honour. It also had lectures by Dr Prof Omondi Ogutu from the University of Nairobi and Prof Anat Gaftner-Gvili from Rabin Medical Centre, Israel among other international and national speakers.

The World Menstrual Hygiene Day was celebrated on 28th May, 2022 by MOGS members at 24 hospitals, small and big nursing homes and private hospitals by giving talks on delivering menstrual hygiene for young adolescent girls and women.

MOGS had organized excellent program for the World Population Day CME and PPH International Conclave. World population Day was celebrated on 11th July 2022 where we had the honour of having Dr R P Soonawala and Dr Usha Krishna as Chief Guests.

Professor Sir Sabaratnam Arul Kumaran our international faculty and Past President of FIGO and RCOG enthralled the audience with his talk on PPH revisited – Challenges and Solutions in PPH at the International PPH Conclave held on 23rd July 2022. Dr Rajendra Saraogi, our MOGS member spoke on influencing factors for the prevention of PPH. Both were awarded the MOGS Global Excellence Awards. MOGS celebrated World breastfeeding week by conducting several

programs like MOGS FOGSI SAFOG UNICEF CME on breastfeeding and World Breastfeeding Week Poster and Slogan Competition. Many MOGS members and non-MOGS members contributed in large numbers. MOGS conducted the SHARP Global Gynecology conference on the 3rd and 4th of September 2022 at the St. Regis Hotel, Mumbai. A total of 16 National & international organizations' faculty were involved. There were 3 pre-congress workshops conducted at various centres in Mumbai on 2nd September 2022. The conference was attended by nearly 500 people with varied interests and age groups that included residents of postgraduate colleges & consultants. There were 23 talks, 12 panel discussions, 31 Keynote Addresses, 3 debates and 2 orations. The MOGS Bhanuben Nanavati Oration was delivered by Dr CN Purandare on Technique of Modified Radical Hysterectomy and the MOGS SHARP Conference Oration was delivered by Dr PC Mahapatra on Dying Art or Growing Science? Difficult Vaginal Hysterectomy. Mrs Vidya Balan, Film Actor was the Guest of Honour and Dr CN Purandare was the Chief Guest. In the evening, there was the MOGS Talent Show where all our members performed. In the evening we had the Vision for HER walk where we had our MOGS Office bearers, managing committee members and youth council members walk with their daughters, sisters, mothers and grandmothers. Dr Shanthakumari, Dr Hrishikesh Pai, Dr Rishma Pai, Dr Nandita Palshetkar, Dr Jaydeep Tank & Dr Rajendrasing Pardesi were felicitated in traditional Maharashtrian style with Pagadi, Shawl & Shreefal and bestowed with Plaque of The MOGS SHARP Global Excellence Award by President MOGS Dr Niranjan Chavan, Office Bearers & Past Presidents of FOGSI & MOGS.

The AICC RCOG Annual Conference 2022 was held from November 4th to 6th, 2022, at CPS College, Parel and Hotel Taj Land's End, Bandra, Mumbai. 4 Pre-conference workshops were held. Challenges in Obstetrics was wonderfully designed by Dr Suchitra Pandit, Dr Anahita Chauhan and Dr Komal Chavan, Dr VP Paily, Dr Tim Draycott and Dr Patrick O'Brien who were faculties for the program. The highlight was the hands-on session on obstetric models. The Infertility Workshop was organized by Dr Ameet Patki, Dr Sunita Tandulwadkar and Dr Anand Nanavati who covered latest developments in the field. Dr Rupin Shah and Dr Firuza Parikh gave excellent talks. Abnormal uterine bleeding workshop was held in collaboration with IAGE. There were 3 Orations given by Prof. Eddie Morris, President, RCOG, Dr Ranee Thakar, Vice President, RCOG and Dr Hrishikesh Pai, President, FOGSI. Dr Abdul Sultan gave the SIMS Black Lecture and Dr Bhaskar Pal gave a wonderful keynote address on C Section rates.

MOGS has organized multiple CMEs like the Diabetes Research Conference organized in association with IMA, The DHEERA CME on Violence against women, MOGS-FOGSI-JOGI PICSEP workshop on Research methodology, a surgical workshop organised in association with SOVSI. We conducted Bone Mineral Densitometry camp, a mega event spanning over several hospitals conducted in celebration of World Osteoporosis Day, Anemia Mukta Bharat Conclave held in celebration of World Iron Deficiency Day which also had a Poster & Slogan Competition in which several MOGS members and non-MOGS members contributed in large numbers. MOGS had organized a CME with Teacher's Felicitation Program on 25th Sept 2022 at Hotel Taj Santacruz. IAVA World Congress 2022 on Functional and Aesthetic Gynecology was held in association with MOGS on 10th & 11th December, 2023 at Hotel J W Marriott, Juhu, Mumbai. HOD Meeting and Program for inculcating culture of scientific enquiry and pursuit workshop (PICSEP) were organized at LTMMC Sion.

The 51st MOGS GOLDS Annual Conference was held on 11th and 12th February at Hotel JW Marriott, Juhu. We had a total of 850 registrations for this event. The conference was titled the MOGS GOLDS – Gynecology and Obstetrics Learning Dilemmas Solved – Conference. The themes for the Conference were Minimal Access Gynecological Surgeries, Emergency & Operative Obstetrics, and Modern Technology in Fertility Control. The inauguration was conducted in a crisp and concise manner. The Chief Guest for the inauguration was Dr Hrishikesh Pai and Guest of Honour was Ms Varsha Usgaonkar. The MOGS prizes were given during the inauguration. The scientific program consisted of 5 orations, over 40 didactic lectures, 11 panel discussions and a session of debates. There were 100 free papers and 42 posters. Dr Hrishikesh Pai delivered MOGS Dr MD Adatia Oration on What's New in ART! Dr Niranjan Chavan gave the first ever MOGS Presidential oration on What's New in Gynecologic

Oncology! MOGS Dr Shraddhanand Thakur Oration on Lessons Learnt was delivered by Dr Vanita Raut. Dr Frank Louwen spoke on Teach the Breech - Safety First for All while delivering MOGS Dr Usha Krishna Oration. MOGS Dr Subhash Penkar and Dr Marie Pereira Oration was given by Dr Pratap Kumar where he spoke on Scarred Uterus - Concerns & Prevention. The scientific program included sessions on MOGS Dr Shirish Sheth Workshop on the Pelvic Floor, MOGS Dr K Sankari Symposium, and the MOGS Dr Ganatra Charitable Trust CME session. The evening entertainment program consisted of the MOGS Dr Rishma Pai Personality Contest, dance and talent competition amongst the MOGS members titled MOGS Got Talent on Toes and was well received. The evening ended with a MOGS Bollywood Bling Fashion Show and Vision for Her Walk. 39 outreach and 6 Dr NA Purandare Teaching Programs were held throughout the year. MOGS Dr Nandita Palshetkar Postgraduate CME 2023 was attended by 570 students. MOGS Cyclothon 2023 - Half The Wheels, Twice the Fun was conducted with success on 29th January 2023.

The MOGS TRENDZ pics and photos of Outreach programs of MOGS are a must see. Hope you had shared your pics all throughout the year with hashtags. A total of 4 MOGS newsletters Buzz & Bytes were released during this tenure.

I am happy to inform that MOGS had bid for the AICOG during the September Managing Committee meeting of FOGSI and in January 2025 we will be hosting AICOG 2025 in Mumbai.

I would like to conclude by thanking the MOGS Trustees, MOGS Managing Council, Office Bearers, Youth Council and my family members who have given me immense support during my tenure as President MOGS.

I am thankful to the MOGS staff Divyaben, Manohar, Hemant, Naresh and Mandar who have worked hard to ensure smooth working of MOGS.

FOGSI Awards 2021-22

The MOGS year 2021-22 was marked by excellent teamwork amongst members of the Managing Council. MOGS has been awarded the FOGSI - Dr Sadhana Desai Population Stabilization Promotion Prize 2022 for the best activities in Category "A" Societies for the year 2021-2022 at AICOG Kolkata in January 2023.

The year continued with the important annual academic events of the society while also experimenting with and introducing a number of changes and innovations as outlined in the report below. 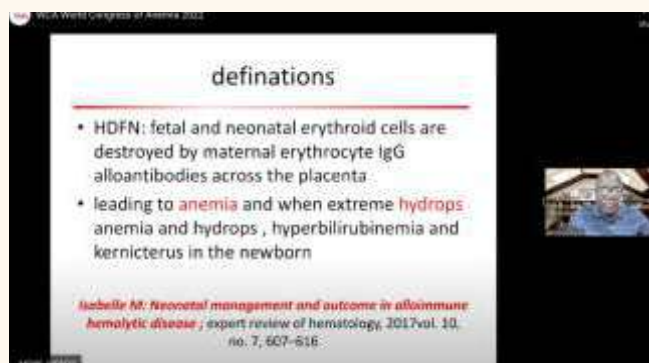

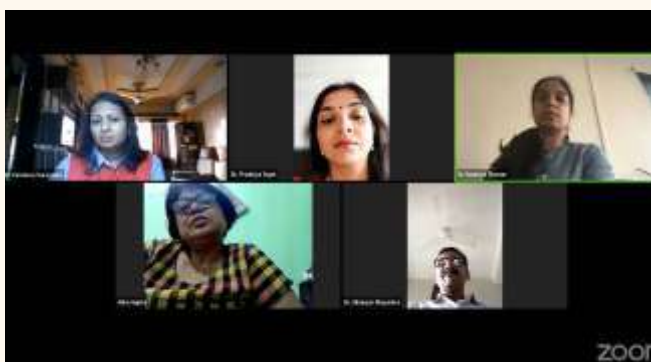

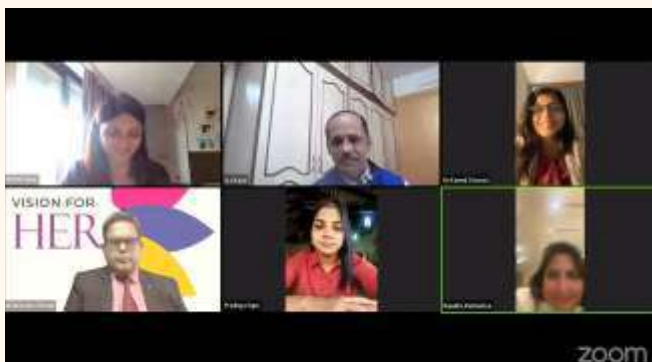


MOGS Dr Nandita Palshetkar Postgraduate CME

The five days MOGS Postgraduate CME was a virtual intensive preparatory programme held over 2 phases. Phase 1: 7th - 9th April, 2023 Phase 2: 15th - 16th April, 2023. Dr Shailesh Kore was the Chief Convener and Officer Bearer-in-charge. The conveners were - Phase 1: Dr Priti Vyas, Dr Mansi Medhekar, Dr Madhuri Mehendale, Phase 2: Dr Komal Chavan, Dr Punit Bhojani, Dr Pradnya Supe.

We had total of 570 registrations from Mumbai and all over India. 150 faculty members from various teaching hospitals not only from Mumbai but from all over India participated in the programme. The Maharashtra Medical Council had granted 8 (4+4) credit points for the course. ICOG granted 20 credit points for the course.

The program was inaugurated on 7th April by Dr Nirnanjan Chavan, Dr Nandita Palshetkar (Chief Guest) and Dr Shailesh Kore. Apart from 30 long case presentation/discussions, 18 short cases, Ward round and 17 Viva discussions on exam related topics, the PG-CME also included lectures on Orientation for PG exam, Obstetric Anal Sphincter Injuries and their preventive strategies, Energy Sources in Gynaecological surgeries, Partograph & POP-Q. There was also a session on OSCE in MRCOG and a session on the approach to MRCOG exams.

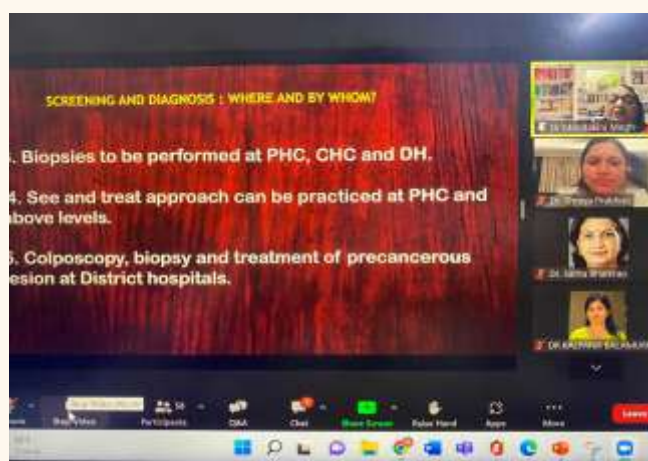
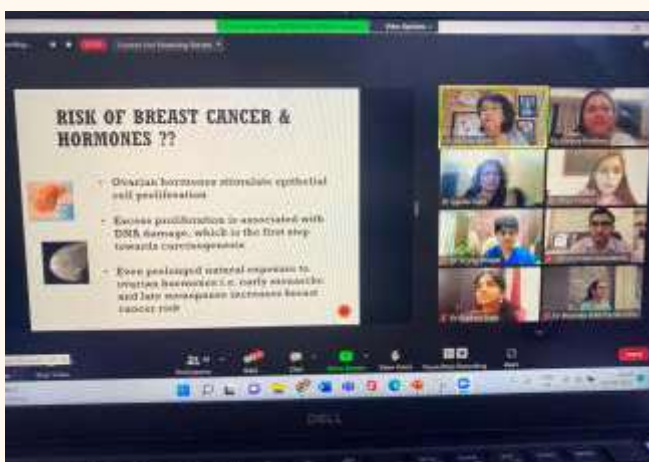






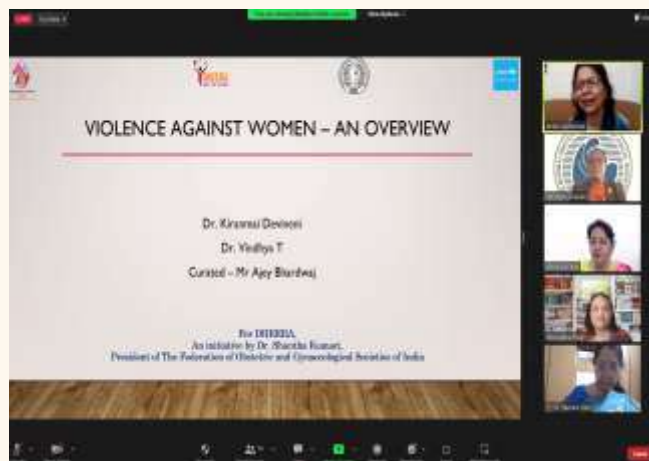














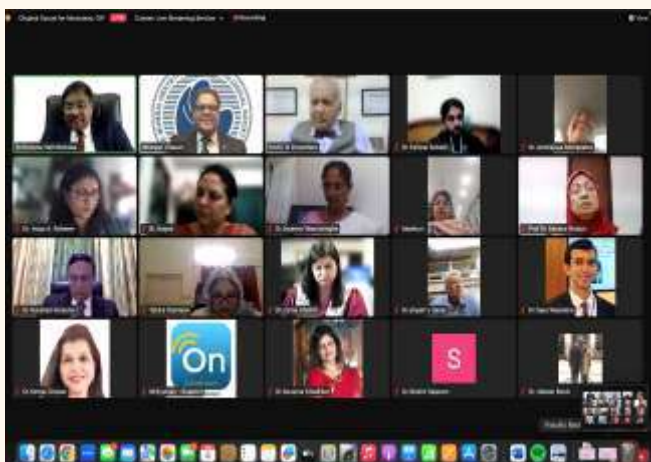














Social Activities 2022-2023

Survey on Cervical Cancer

Observational study was conducted on “Cervical Cancer Awareness among Obstetrician and Gynecologist” over the period of one month from 1st January 2023 to 31st January 2023. This survey was launched on 4th February on the occasion of World Cancer Day by Mumbai Obstetrics and Gynecological Society in association with SAFOG Oncology Committee. Various aspects regarding risk factors associated with cervical cancer, screening methods, ideal screening methods, vaccination strategies and prevention of cervical cancer was discussed in detail. Data collection was done on common practice and general awareness about cervical cancer and its screening strategies in management of cervical cancer by Gynecologist. The survey was answered online by 113 Doctors and is still in circulation. All the parameters are studied and analysed on the basis of percentages. All parameters were analysed using descriptive statistics i.e. percentages and proportions are calculated.

Questionnaire was prepared in English and its content validity was assessed by two co-investigators and then sent to Obstetricians and Gynecologist via WhatsApp, Gmail & Social media. All answers were collected and results were prepared from given answers.

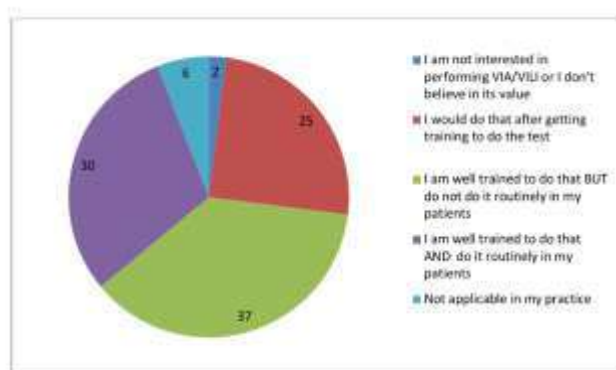


Figure 11: As a clinician how confident are you in performing VIA/VILI for your patients routinely?

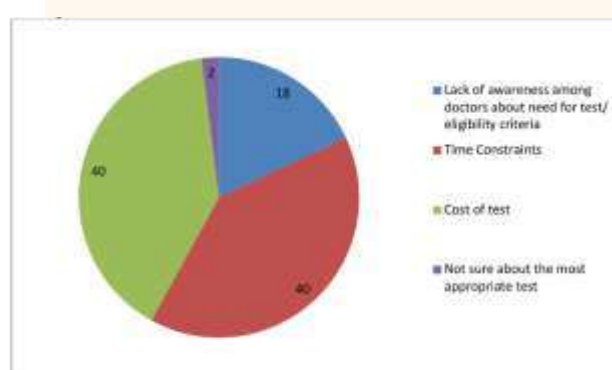


Figure 12: Most important barrier (from the Doctors' point of view) in the real-world practice in recommending cervical cancer screening test?



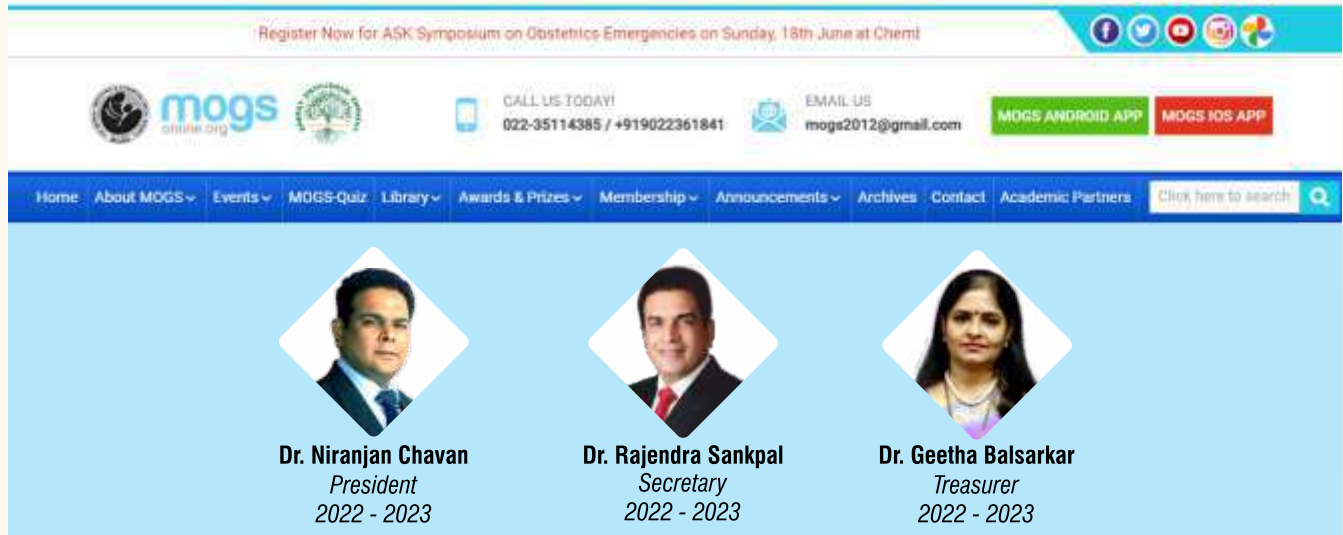

An MOGS membership drive was conducted during December and January wherein a concessional rate of Rs 15,000/- including GST was offered to upgrade Ordinary members to Life members.

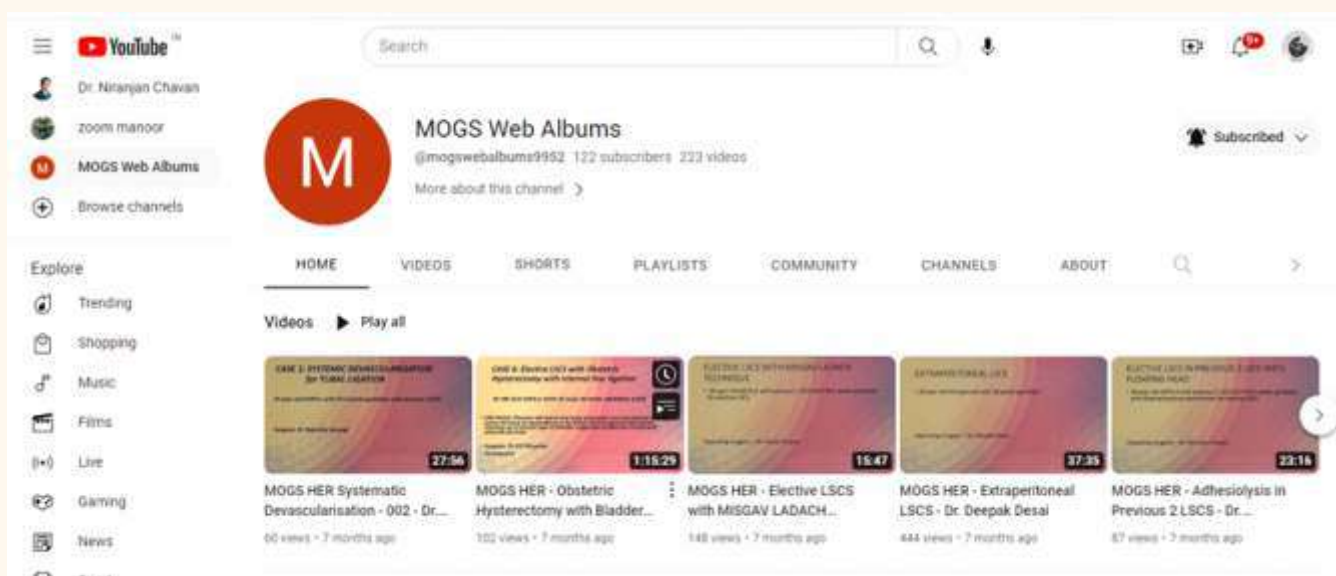
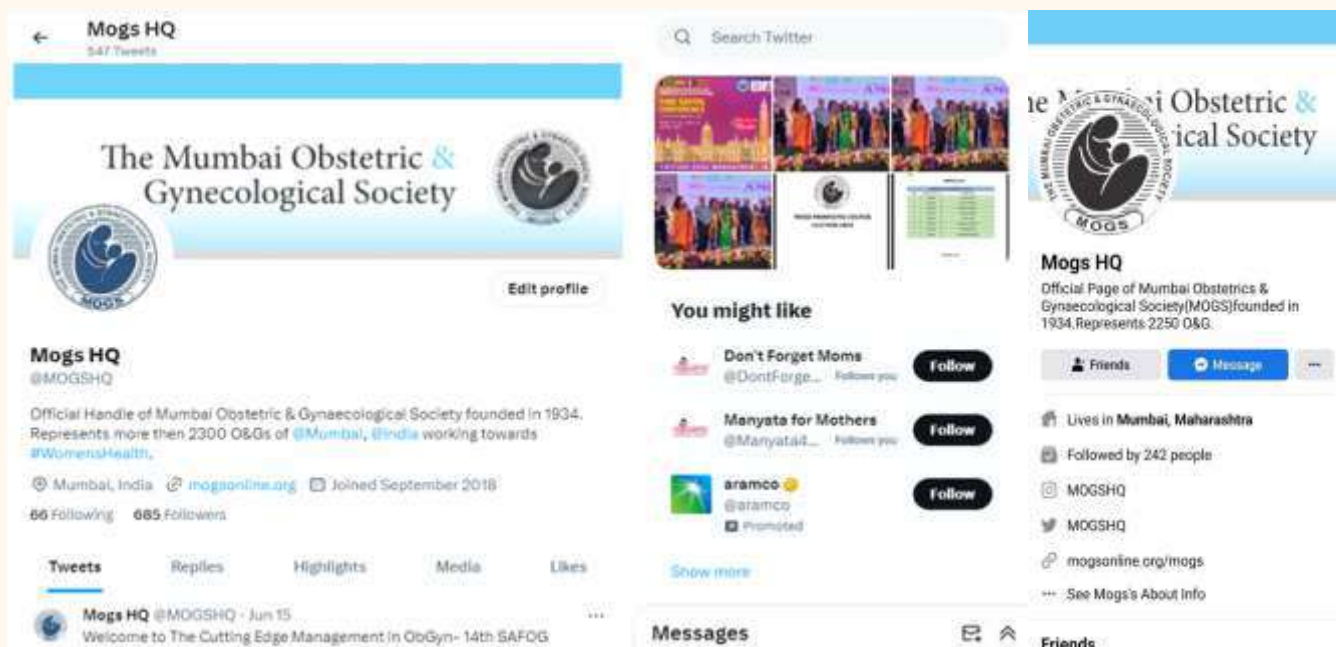


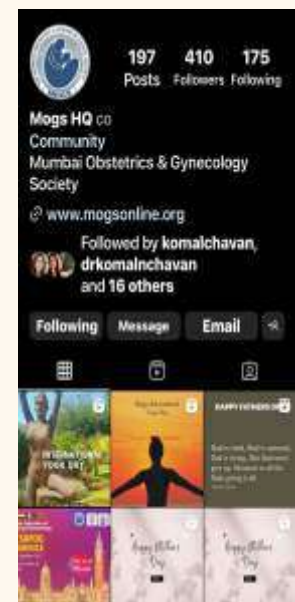

मुंबईतील ५.२ टक्के नागरिक ऑस्टिओपोरोसिसने बाधित

नागरिकांनी काळजी घेण्याचे आवाहन

जागतिक ऑस्टिओपोरोसिस दिनानिमित्त मुंबई ऑब्स्टेट्रिक्स अँड गायनॅकोलॉजिकल सोसायटीमार्फत बोन मिनरल डेन्सिटोमेट्री ऑस्टिओपोरोसिस तपासणी मोफत शिबीर आयोजित करण्यात आले होते. मुंबई शहर आणि उपनगरातील ३८ केंद्रावर या शिबिरांचे आयोजन करण्यात आले होते. यावेळी जास्तीत जास्त बोन मिनरल डेन्सिटोमेट्री मूल्यांकन करण्याचा जागतिक विजय केला. या शिबिरामध्ये हाडांच्या खनिज घनतेसाठी ४००० पेक्षा जास्त रुग्णांची तपासणी करण्यात आली. त्यापैकी २०० (५.२ टक्के) रुग्णांना ऑस्टिओपोरोसिस असल्याचे आढळून आले. १७०० (४७.६ टक्के) रुग्णांना -१.० ते -२.५ च्या टी स्कोअरसह ऑस्टियोपेनिया होता. तपासणी करण्यात आलेल्या रुग्णांपैकी १६६० (४१.२ टक्के) रुग्ण पदवीधारक, १४०० (२८.९ टक्के) माध्यमिक शाळेचे शिक्षण पूर्ण केले होते. तर ७०० (१७.३ टक्के) प्राथमिक शालेय शिक्षण पूर्ण केले होते आणि ३१२ (८.८ टक्के) अशिक्षित होते. या रुग्णांच्या केलेल्या तपासणीमध्ये सुमारे ७५ टक्के रुग्ण आहारातील पूरक आहार घेत नव्हते, तर उर्वरित २५ टक्के लोक आधीच कॅल्शियम आणि व्हिटॅमिन डी असा पूरक आहार घेत असल्याचे स्पष्ट झाले.

हाडांच्या निर्मितीसाठी आणि हाडे निरोगी आणि मजबूत बनवण्यासाठी कॅल्शियम हा एक महत्वाचा घटक आहे. त्यामुळे सर्व वयोगटातील महिलांमधील ऑस्टिओपोरोसिस शोधण्यासाठी बोन मिनरल डेन्सिटोमेट्रीचे मापन करून त्यांच्या हाडातील व्हिटॅमिन डीची पातळी तपासणे हा या शिबिराचा उद्देश होता.


