

MOGS – Dr. Shantabai Gulabchand Travelling Fellowship Award

Criteria

- 1) MOGS Member continuously minimum 5 years.
- 2) Age: Not more than 35 years.
- 3) The candidate should be holding a Post Graduate qualification (preferably a degree)
in the subject of OBGYN (or allied subject like Neonatology).
- 4) The candidate shall attach with it his / her Curriculum Vitae, stressing on academic
achievement, presentation of paper at conferences and publications in Journal.
- 5) The applicant shall attach two References / Recommendations (One of them should be the head of Institution / Department / Unit if presently working in an institution) with the application.
- 6) The candidate shall also state the institution he desires to work at, approximate period
should be 3 to 4) weeks to be spent at the institution and the type of training involved,
along with provisional letter of acceptance by the institution.
- 7) The selected candidate will be paid 75% of the Travelling Fellowship amount (to take care of the expenses involved for about 3 to 4 weeks, such as stay in hostel / economy hotel, return economy class airfare and stipend of US \$ 500) before proceeding for the educational trip. Balance 25% will be paid on return and after submitting the Fellowship report along with the statement of expenses.
- 8) On completion of the task decided to be undertaken and within four weeks of return the candidate will file the report, along with statement of expenses, to the MOGS. The MOGS in turn will forward a copy of the same to the Donors.
- 9) At an important function of the MOGS preferably the Annual Conference, the Awardee of Travelling Fellowship of the year will be felicitated with a memento. The Awardee may be requested to make a short presentation of his experience of the Fellowship. The donors of the MOGS-Dr.Shantabai Gulabchand Travelling Fellowship Award” shall be intimated of this function requesting them to grace occasion by their personal presence or by their representative.
- 10) The presentation made by the awardee shall be published in the “News & Views” or any suitable publication of the MOGS.
- 11) In cases of failure on the part of the candidate who is awarded the Fellowship to successfully complete the task envisaged, he / she will have to return all the money paid to him / her and he / she will not be eligible for any Awards, prizes or any other benefits of any kind from the society in future. The candidate will have to sign necessary undertaking for the same, with the society.
