### **Proposed Amendments to the Constitution:**

# I. Vacancy in Managing Council (Details given below)

## **Existing Clause :-**

- ❖ Non attendance of a member of The Managing Council at three consecutive meetings without permission or leave of absence of the President shall constitute a vacancy.
- ❖ If a member of the Managing Council continues to be absent for four consecutive Managing Council meetings with or without permission, this shall constitute a vacancy. Such members shall cease to be a member of the Managing Council and will not be eligible to be a members for the next 3 years.

## Proposed amendment :-

- ❖ Non attendance of a member of the Managing Council at three consecutive meetings without permission or leave of absence of the President shall constitute a vacancy.
- ❖ If a member of the Managing Council continues to be absent for four consecutive Managing Council meetings with or without permission, this shall constitute a vacancy. Such members shall cease to be a member of the Managing Council and will not be eligible to be a member for the next 3 years.
- ❖ The section 19(a) and (b) shall not be applicable to the five immediate Past Presidents or if the member cannot attend the meetings due to official MOGS or FOGSI assignments pre informed to the President and Secretary.

#### II. E - Voting.

#### **Existing Clause:**

#### **POSTAL BALLOT:-**

Should the number of nominations for any elected post or post of Member of Managing Council exceed the number of vacancies, an election by a secret ballot to choose the winning candidate will be held by postal ballot prior to the Annual General Meeting of the Society.

# **Proposed amendment:**

# **POSTAL BALLOT :-**

Should the number of nominations for any elected post or post of Member of Managing Council exceed the number of vacancies, an election by a secret ballot **or any electronic means** or any other means to choose the winning candidate will be held prior to the Annual General Meeting of the society.
